Directions:

<u>From the west</u> travel on Hwy 12 eastbound over White Pass. Go past Rimrock Lake and the Rimrock Grocery Store. Take the Tieton Road to the right. (Do not take the first Tieton Road before Rimrock Lake)++

<u>From the east</u> take Hwy 12 westbound past Rimrock Retreat to Tieton Road and turn left. Do not go past the Rimrock Store.++

++Go over the bridge and take the first left (very sharp left hairpin turn) into the large camping/parking area. There should be a CMO directional plate. Fifth wheels/gooseneck trailers need to go past the first left and turn around at the next road intersection and approach the turn from that direction
