#### From the North:

Take Hwy 512 east, follow Hwy 7 (23 miles)

Hwy 161 (Meridian) south (12 miles) Turn right onto 304th Street (3 miles). Turn left onto Hwy 7 (10 miles). Turn right onto Mashel Práirie Road. 1/4 mile to parking under power lines.

From Yelm:
Follow Hwy 702 to Hwy 7 (10 miles). Turn right onto Hwy 7 (10 miles). Turn right onto Mashel Prairie Road. ¼ mile to parking under power lines. From Elbe:

Follow Hwy 7 for 12 miles. Turn left onto Mashel Prairie Road. 1/4 mile to parking under power lines.
