

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Driving Directions to Sahara Creek DNR Horse Camp: Take State Route 7 to Elbe, follow State Route 706 EAST for 5.3 miles. Watch for mile marker 5 and be prepared to turn LEFT as soon as you see it. The camp sign is very small and easily missed. GPS Coordinates: 46.758258819580N, 122.08489227294W NOTE: Sahara Creek DNR Horse Camp is a NO FEE campground though camping in Sahara Creek Horse Camp is by reservation only. Email saharacreekcampreservations@gmail.com to make a reservation. Note: Stays in Sahara Creek Camp are limited to 7 days in a 30-day period, a DNR Discover Pass is required. The Camp features drive-thru sites, high line poles, hitching rails, manure bins, picnic tables, fire pits, non-potable stock water, pit toilets and a large central picnic shelter.


Driving Directions to Memorial Park Day Use Area: Take State Route 7 to the WEST edge of Elbe, turn NORTH onto DNR Road 5. Follow Road 5 for 1.5 miles (Steep Grade) then bear LEFT. Trailhead parking is 0.1 miles on the RIGHT. NOTE: Gate 511 on Road 5 at Hwy. 7 is locked September 1 thru March 15.
